- Demonstrates excellence in teaching and engaging students in dance
- Adopts innovative strategies for teaching dance within the North Carolina Essential Standards
- Actively pursues artistic and professional development through workshops, performances and conferences
- Works to connect school, family, and community resources by involving students in trips, performances, and events

- A person who has made a significant contribution to dance education through advocacy, special projects, fundraising, and/or volunteer work, above and beyond expectations.
