
Going to Sleeping Beauty -A Fairy Tailored Classic-






There are a lot of fun things to see at the ballet, including dancers in costumes and beautiful scenery.






First, we have to drive to the theater, park the car and walk over to the theater.

After I go through the lobby, an usher will help me find my seat in the theater.






I will enter the theater and wait for the ballet to start.
