## BUNDLED & FLEXIBLE CLASS OPTIONS

### *Available to Primary, Intermediate, and Advanced Levels*

Charlotte Ballet Academy offers students placed in Ballet 2 – Ballet 5 the opportunity to bundle their classes at a special rate. **Ballet Bundles** are curated by our Academy Directors to provide the skills students need for each stage of their development as a dancer. **Flex** options are designed for students to scale their program one class at a time. Specialty class styles listed on the Academy Schedule are subject to change based on faculty availability.

## PLACEMENT CLASSES

Students new to Charlotte Ballet Academy may require a placement class prior to enrollment. Please visit [charlotteballet.org/class-placement](http://charlotteballet.org/class-placement) to schedule a placement class for your dancer.

## TUITION POLICIES

**All tuition and fees paid are non-refundable and non-transferable. No portion of tuition will be refunded or transferred** in the event of absence, injury, relocation, decision to withdraw, or dismissal from the Academy. No portion of tuition may be credited for future programming. Future monthly payments may be canceled upon written notice of withdrawal from the Academy. In the event of withdrawal, a 30 calendar day notice must be given. Should a scheduled payment occur within the 30 day window, full payment is due.

Charlotte Ballet Academy reserves the right to withdraw students who have not attended any of their scheduled classes for 30 calendar days. Withdrawals due to lapsed attendance are not eligible for any refunds. Should a scheduled payment occur within the 30 calendar day lapsed attendance, the parent is responsible for the full payment due.

## MONTHLY INSTALLMENT PLANS

- Total tuition for the 2025/2026 School Year will be paid in **ten equal payments**, including the tuition deposit.
- **Payment Schedule:** First installment (a 10% deposit) plus applicable registration fees are due at the time of registration. Credit card will be charged automatically on the first of each month for nine additional installments, beginning August 1, 2025 and ending April 1, 2026. A valid credit card must be kept on file at all times.

## LATE FEES

- **An automatic late fee of \$20** will apply to any automatic payment that is unpaid 7 days after the first of the month. It is the client's responsibility to maintain a valid credit card information at all times.

## REGISTRATION FEES

In addition to the tuition deposit (first installment), there are several one-time registration fees due upon enrollment. Registration fees vary by level and the package you've selected.

- **Parent Guild Fee - \$25:** Cover the cost and operations of the Academy Parent Guild.
- **Registration Fee - \$80:** Covers the cost of the registration software and the staff to support families during registration.
- **Facility Fee - \$50:** Covers the cost of facility cleaning & maintenance of high-quality air filters
- **Preparatory Performance Fee - \$40:** Helps to cover the costs associated with the end of the year performance including facility expense, costume management, costume building, staff and production crew for run-throughs, rehearsals, and performances. Tickets are included in this fee.
- **Primary, Intermediate, and Advanced Performance Fee(s) - \$80 (first class), \$20 (supplemental classes):** Helps to cover the costs associated with the end of year performance including facility expense, costume management, costume building, staff and production crew for run-throughs, rehearsals, and performances. Tickets are not included in this fee.

## IMPORTANT CALENDAR DATES

- **Nutcracker Auditions are scheduled for August 23, 2025.** Eligible students must be at least 9 years old and currently enrolled in a Charlotte Ballet Academy Program.
- **All classes begin August 25, 2025.** Please refer to the 2025/2026 Academy Calendar for other important dates throughout the year.
- **Preparatory Division Classes** conclude with the Preparatory Spring Showcase on May 17, 2026.
- **Primary, Intermediate, and Advanced Division Classes** conclude with the Primary and Festival Spring Performances on June 7, 2026.



# PREPARATORY DIVISION CLASSES & SCHEDULE

## *The Joy of Movement Starts Here*

Classes are appropriate for students ages 3+. Classes begin August 25, 2025, and conclude with the Preparatory Showcase on May 17, 2026. Each section meets once per week throughout the school year. Parents should select a class for their student based on their age as of September 15, 2025. Charlotte Ballet Academy reserves the right to change class placement based upon an individual student's maturity and physical strength.

### CREATIVE MOVEMENT (AGES 3 & 4)

In a fun and encouraging environment, students explore musicality, rhythm, creativity and movement through space. This class introduces age-appropriate stretching, basic strengthening, balance, motor skill development, and coordination. Please choose the class section that best suits your schedule.

### PRE-BALLET & TAP (AGES 5 & 6)

This class introduces classical ballet vocabulary, emphasizing musicality and individual creative expression in an innovative, fun, and easy-to-learn matter. Please choose the class section that best suits your schedule. Class time is divided into half ballet and half tap – **ballet and tap shoes are needed.**

### BEGINNING BALLET & TAP (AGES 6+)

This traditionally structured ballet class introduces French Ballet terminology and is designed for students with little or no ballet experience. Please choose the class section that best suits your schedule. Class time is divided into half ballet and half tap – **ballet and tap shoes are needed.**

## BALLET 1 & BOYS DANCE

### *Dance is Your Home*

Classes are appropriate for students ages 8+. Classes begin August 25, 2025, and conclude with the Primary Performance on June 7, 2026. Classes begin at the Cain Center on Thursday, August 28, 2025. New students must take a **placement class** to enroll into this Division. Charlotte Ballet Academy recommends that students ages 6-9 who are brand new to ballet consider enrolling in Beginning Ballet (see Preparatory Division on page 4). All dancers are encouraged to take the **SPECIALTY CLASSES** available to them.

#### BALLET 1 (AGES 8+)

Classes are available by audition only. Ballet 1 **requires two classes per week** in the same section. Please choose the class section that best suits your schedule.

#### BOYS DANCE (AGES 8+)

Boys Dance classes are available by audition only. Boys Dance **requires two classes per week**. Boys Dance tuition is subsidized by Charlotte Ballet Academy, but registration fees still apply.

## BALLET 2A & 2B | *Dance is Your Home*

Classes are appropriate for students ages 9+. Classes begin August 25, 2025, and conclude with the Primary Spring Performance on June 7, 2026. New students must take a placement class to enroll into this Division.

### BALLET 2A (AGES 9+)

Classes are best suited for students ages 9+ who have taken at least one year of Ballet 2 curriculum. Ballet 2 requires **three classes per week** in the same section. Female students in Ballet 2A must take **POINTE STRENGTH TRAINING** (PST).

### BALLET 2B (AGES 9+)

Classes are best suited for students ages 9+ who are new to Ballet 2 curriculum. Ballet 2 requires three classes per week in the same section. Please choose the class section that best suits your schedule. A shortened **POINTE STRENGTH TRAINING** class is now optional for female dancers in Ballet 2B (30 minutes twice per week). Please choose the class section that best suits your schedule.

### BOYS 2 (AGES 9+)

BOYS 2 is required for students in Ballet 2A and optional for students in Ballet 2B.

### BALLET 3 (AGES 10+)

Ballet 3A & 3B require **four classes per week**. 3B is best suited for dancers who are new to Ballet 3, while 3A is best suited for dancers who have completed at least one full year of Ballet 3 curriculum. Ladies in Level 3 are required to take **POINTE 3**. Men in Level 3 are required to take **BOYS 3**.

### BALLET 4 (AGES 10+)

Ballet 4 requires **four classes per week**. Ballet 4A is best suited for students who have taken at least one year of Ballet 4 curriculum. Ballet 4B is best suited for students who are new to the Ballet 4 curriculum. **BALLET 4 SUPPLEMENTAL** is an optional fifth day of technique available to all Level 4 dancers. All ladies in Ballet 4 must take **POINTE 4**. All men in Ballet 4 must take **PAS DE DEUX**. To support their participation, men in Level 4B should take Ballet 4A Technique on Tuesday in lieu of their Wednesday technique class.

# INTERMEDIATE DIVISION TUITION

Charlotte Ballet Academy recommends that students enroll in **Ballet Bundles** to maximize their journey through dance education. The **Ballet 3A** and **Ballet 3B Bundles** include Ballet 3 Technique classes, Pointe 3 or Boys 3, and a Specialty 3 – Jazz class. Student Ensemble 3 may be added, if desired.

The **Ballet 4A** and **Ballet 4B Bundles** include all Level 4 classes: Ballet 4 Technique, Pointe 4 (women) or Pas de Deux (men), Specialty 4, and Student Ensemble 4. An optional fifth day of technique (Ballet 4 Supplemental) may be added, if desired.

The **Ballet 3A** and **Ballet 3B Flex** options only include Ballet 3 Technique and Pointe 3 or Boys classes. Specialty classes, including Student Ensemble 3, may be added as desired.

The **Ballet 4A** and **Ballet 4B Flex** options only include Ballet 4 Technique and Pointe 4 or Men's 4 classes. Specialty classes, including Student Ensemble 4, may be added as desired.

### BALLET 5 BUNDLE

The Ballet 5 Bundle is an accelerated track available for dancers preparing for collegiate level training and/or a professional career in dance. The Ballet 5 Bundle includes all Level 5 classes: Ballet 5 Technique, Pointe/Variations or Men's, Pas de Deux, Specialty 5 – Contemporary, and Student Ensemble 5.

### BALLET 5 FLEX

The Ballet 5 Flex option only includes Ballet 5 Technique and Pointe/Variations or Men's classes. Male dancers are required to take Pas de Deux, but female dancers are not required. Specialty classes, including Student Ensemble 5, may be added as desired.
