## SUPPLEMENTAL CLASSES

## AVAILABLE TO PRIMARY, INTERMEDIATE, AND ADVANCED LEVELS

Charlotte Ballet Academy requires that students take the **Ballet** and **Pointe** or **Men's** classes assigned to them after their evaluation. It is also recommended that students take supplemental classes as they are able (Specialty Classes and Student Ensemble). Intermediate and Advanced students who enroll into Student Ensemble take part in an additional Center for Dance performance in January 2024. **The Academy will continue to offer curriculum in the Jazz and Modern dance genres through our Specialty classes.** Students will have the opportunity to train in Modern and Jazz technique through dance styles such as Contemporary, Broadway, and Tap. *Scheduled styles are subject to change*. Level 4 students have the option to enroll in a Supplemental Ballet Technique class once per week.

## **TUITION POLICIES**

All tuition and fees paid are non-refundable. No portion of tuition will be refunded in the event of absence, injury, relocation, decision to withdraw, or dismissal from the Academy. No portion of tuition may be credited for future programming. Future monthly payments may be canceled upon written notice of withdrawal from the Academy. In the event of withdrawal, a 30 calendar day notice must be given. Should a scheduled payment occur within the 30 day window, full payment is due.

#### MONTHLY INSTALLMENT PLANS

- Total tuition for the 2023/2024 School Year will be paid in nine equal payments, including the tuition deposit.
- Payment schedule: First installment (tuition deposit) plus applicable registration fees are due at the time of registration. Credit card will be charged automatically on the first of each month for eight additional installments, beginning September 1, 2023 and ending April 1, 2024. A valid credit card must be kept on file at all times.

#### **LATE FEES**

 An automatic credit/debit decline fee of \$10 will apply to any automatic payment that is declined on the auto debit date for any reason. It is the client's responsibility to maintain valid credit card information at all times. Card information can be updated in the Parent Portal under FINANCES.

#### **REGISTRATION FEES**

In addition to the tuition deposit (first installment), there are several one-time registration fees due upon enrollment. Registration fees vary by level and number of classes added.

- Parent Guild Fee \$25: Covers the cost and operations of the Academy Parent Guild
- Registration Fee \$75: Covers the cost of the registration software and the staff to support families during registration
- Facility Fee \$50: Covers the cost of facility cleaning & maintenance of high quality air filters.
- Preparatory Performance Fee \$45: Helps to cover the costs associated with the end of the year performance including facility expense, costume management, costume building, staff and production crew for run-throughs, rehearsals, and performances. Tickets are included in this fee.
- Primary, Intermediate, and Advanced Performance Fee(s) -\$75 (first class), \$25 (supplemental classes): Helps to cover the costs associated with the end of the year performance including facility expense, costume management, costume building, staff and production crew for run-throughs, rehearsals, and performances. Tickets are not included in this fee.

## PREPARATORY DIVISION

Classes are appropriate for students ages 3+. Each section meets **once per week** throughout the school year. Parents should select a class for their student based on their age as of August 28, 2023. Charlotte Ballet Academy reserves the right to change class placement based upon an individual student's maturity and physical strength.

## CREATIVE MOVEMENT (AGES 3 & 4)

In a fun and encouraging environment, students explore musicality, rhythm, creativity and movement through space. This class introduces age-appropriate stretching, basic strengthening, balance, motor skill development, and coordination. Please choose the class section that best suits your schedule.

## **BEGINNING BALLET (AGES 6+)**

This traditionally structured ballet class includes French Ballet terminology and is designed for students with little or no ballet experience. Please choose the class section that best suits your schedule.

- Students who are new to ballet training will learn fundamental exercises and proper alignment, maintaining an emphasis on musicality, development of overall body strength, and the enjoyment of moving.
- Students who have completed the Academy's Pre-Ballet curriculum will continue to develop necessary foundational ballet skills to be prepared for Ballet

## **PRIMARY DIVISION**

Classes are appropriate for students ages 7+. Classes begin August 29, 2022, and conclude with the Primary Performance on June 4, 2023. New students must take **a placement class** to enroll into this Division. Charlotte Ballet Academy recommends that students ages 6–9 who are brand new to ballet consider enrolling in Beginning Ballet (see Preparatory Division)

## BALLET 1 & BOYS DANCE (AGES 7+)

- BALLET 1 classes are available by audition only. Ballet 1 requires two classes per week in the same section. Please choose the class section that best suits your schedule.
- BOYS DANCE classes are available by audition only. Boys Dance requires two classes per week. Boys Dance tuition is subsidized by Charlotte Ballet Academy, but registration fees still apply.
- All dancers are encouraged to take the Specialty Classes available to them.

## BALLET 2 & YOUTH BALLET

- Level 2A classes are best suited for students' ages 8+ who have taken at least one year of Ballet 2 curriculum. Ballet 2 requires three classes per week in the same section. Female students in Ballet 2A must take Pointe Strength Training (PST). Please choose the class section that best suits your schedule.
- Level 2B classes are best suited for students ages 8+ who are new to Ballet 2 curriculum. Ballet 2 requires three classes per week in the same section. Please choose the class section that best suits your schedule.
- Male students in Ballet 2A and 2B are encouraged to take Boys 2.
- All dancers are encouraged to take the **Specialty Class** available to them (both fall and spring semesters). Specialty dance styles are subject to change.

## **BALLET 4**

- Ballet 4 requires four classes per week at the Center for Dance. Ballet 4A is best suited for students who have taken at least one year of Ballet 4 curriculum. Ballet 4B is best suited for students who are new to the Ballet 4 curriculum. Ballet 4 Supplemental is an optional fifth day of technique available to all Level 4 dancers.
- All Ladies in Ballet 4 must take Pointe 4. All Men in Ballet 4 must take Pas de Deux & Men's 4.
- All dancers are encouraged to take the Specialty Classes available to them (both fall and spring semesters). Specialty dance styles are subject to change.

## **ADVANCED DIVISION**

## BALLET 5

Level 5 is appropriate for students with a significant ballet training background. All Level 5 classes are held at the Center for Dance. All Ladies in Ballet 5 are required to take Pointe/Variations. All Men in Ballet 5 are required to take Pas de Deux & Men's 5. Specialty dance styles are subject to change.

• Ballet 5: Extension is an accelerated track available for dancers preparing for collegiate level training and/or a professional career in ballet. In addition to Ballet Technique, Pointe/Variations & Men's Classes, all dancers are required to take Pas de Deux, Specialty Class and Student Ensemble.

• Ballet 5: Flex is available for dancers who aren't able to commit to the full Ballet 5 schedule. Dancers are required to take all Ballet Technique, Pointe & Men's classes. Male dancers are required to take Pas de Deux\*, but female dancers are not required to take this class. No dancers are required to take Specialty Class\* or Student Ensemble\*. \*Pas de Deux may be added on a bi-weekly basis for an additional charge. Specialty Classes may be added to your weekly schedule for an additional charge.
